Dear Attorney Pelosky:

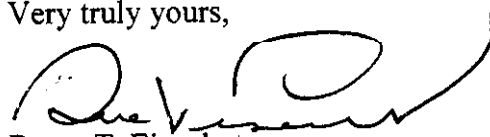
Thank you for your letter of August 12, 2014. The file you referenced was closed in November 2006.

As best I understand it, you are alleging that GE Corporation may not have been paid the \$983.95 as set forth in the final account filed by Attorney George Nader in June 2004.

As a preliminary matter, the complaint is stale within the meaning of our rules. Bank records would not be available to document whether a disbursement was made or not. Attorney Nader may still have a file, and we will ask, but it is beyond the mandatory time period for keeping such financial records or the file. The letter from the Inspector General is not dispositive. I also note the letter was written in September 2012 and it is now almost two years later.

As indicated, I will write to Attorney Nader to ask if he has any record that documents the disbursement to GE Corporation as set forth in the final account.

Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

After diligent search, I was unable to locate my file for the Chapter 11 case of Compol, Inc., Case No. 03-10920-MWV. Accordingly, I do not have a copy of the check representing a dividend distribution of \$983.95, which I made to GE Corporation, as disbursing agent under the debtor's confirmed Chapter 11 plan of reorganization.

In a Chapter 11 case, distribution is typically made to all creditors who have filed proofs of claim in the case, as well as all creditors listed by the debtor in its bankruptcy schedules. I assume that GE Corporation was listed by the debtor in its bankruptcy schedules (signed by Mr. Karkota and filed with the bankruptcy court), and that is why I made a dividend distribution of \$983.95 to GE Corporation back in 2004.

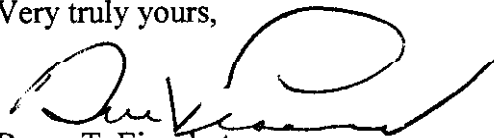
